Shannons Toranafest Supercruise - Saturday 14th - there is parking at the top carpark of Club Maitland City @ Rutherford. There will be a drivers briefing at 10.45am and cruise will leave at 11am for "Torana's at Tocal", where you will be able to purchase a BBQ lunch & drinks, supporting the Tocal College Student Association. Our VIP's will not be at the cruise .

Our VIP's will be in attendance and can we please ask that you refrain from autograph signing, we want our VIP's to enjoy their meal & evening, they will be available on Sunday at Maitland Park for autographs. Ansens Toranafest Show n Shine - Sunday 15th - please arrive between 7.30am (no earlier) and 9am, you must enter via Park Street (see attached map), when you arrive at the pre-enter area you will be asked your last name which will be ticked off the "entrant sheet" as it is printed alphabetically, we have deliberately not given out entry numbers as this causes confusion.



You will then proceed to the next checkpoint where you will be asked if you are parking with a club or not, you will then be directed to park on the field.

For those who will be trailering their torana's you will drive through the Maitland Park to the pre-enter area to have your name ticked off and you will be directed to a grassed area to park and off-load your Torana.

Once parked, please go to the Entrant Registration area and receive your goody bag, car entry sticker & Sunday event programme, please place entrant sticker on your windscreen to assist with judging.

Maitland Park is an “Alcohol Free Area” and overnight camping is NOT permitted.

Passengers & Spectators – free entry

Shade Shelters/banners etc - you are NOT permitted to put pegs into the playing fields. Please ensure you have a means of securing your shade shelter to the ground by means of sand bags or the likes.

We do not want any cars damaged or people injured by flying shade shelters or the likes. If damage occurs to property or people injured you will be held accountable.

Merchandise - for sale will be shirts, kids shirts, caps, stubby holders, bar mats and a few other items, payment either by cash or credit card (via Paypal which attracts a 3% fee), same payment methods apply for the 12.30pm auction.

Ladies Shirts – we have ordered a limited supply of ladies sizes (8 to 20), if you wish to swap your mens entrant shirt for a ladies shirt please go to the Merchandise tent early.

Judging – Judging is by our sponsors and all awards are “Sponsors Choice”.

For the kids – Maitland Park has its own kids playground and indoor aquatic centre (about 200m away).

Dog Rescue – please remember to bring some donations – dry or canned dog/cat food, bedding (old towels & sheets), flea & worm treatments, leads & collars etc, Dog Rescue Newcastle will have a stall where you can drop off your donations.



Be Like Bill Be a Hero - this year we would like to welcome a ‘call to action’ on organ donation. The Canberra Torana Club lost a wonderful young man a few years ago and his organs were donated. Bill Spencer, a Torana enthusiast and active member of the Canberra Torana Club, was only 26 when he tragically lost his life. He became an organ donor and saved the lives of 5 people and restored sight to another 2. Bill’s family have seen firsthand how this has changed the lives of the recipient and also their loved ones. A Facebook page called ‘**Be like Bill – Be a Hero**’ has been started to help raise awareness of **DonateLife** for Organ & Tissue donation. Our aim is to encourage people to register to become an organ donor. Registration can be done at the ‘**Be Like Bill – Be a Hero**’ marquee that will be set up at Toranafest Sunday Show and Shine.

Finish time – Trophy Presentation is at 2.45pm, with Toranafest Show n Shine finishing at 3.30pm, if you need to leave early, you must contact a Hunter Valley Torana Club member who will escort you out, this is part of our Traffic Management Plan.

If it Rains – we can't control the weather and this event cannot be postponed, if the ground is too wet Maitland Council will not let us park on the grounds, alternate arrangements will be emailed to entrants & made public on the Toranafest Website & Facebook page.
